PCC Meeting 7th July 2011

Bible reading and prayer: Steve read from Psalm 127. God is powerful, and it is God who gives growth; it is not for us to control God.

Musicians' report: The team of musicians serve the church by practising and playing in services, and choosing music and searching out new songs. They are keen to hear from musicians who could join them and to hear new song suggestions.

Growth options: We discussed adding a second, parallel morning Sunday service. This would not begin until enough people were committed, and teams of children's workers and musicians were in place. The plans will be presented to the church family at the Vision Evening on 14th September.

Building: The PCC approved stonework repairs for the west wall of Christ Church. We discussed the building project, and timings for a Gift Day. Richard Newman presented to us plans for movable partitions to help Sunday Club make best use of the hall.
